

Announcement: The Commonwealth of Massachusetts Asian American Commission's Young Leaders Scholarship

Dear Applicant:

Recognizing the attribution of higher education to personal and professional success while being a leader, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Asian American Commission (AAC) is pleased to issue a scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 for a current college student to use towards their undergraduate education expenses. Note: Applicants may apply for other AAC scholarships but will be limited to being awarded only one of the scholarships they apply for.

The scholarship committee will determine applicants who will get awarded the scholarship listed above.

Applicant Criterion:

- 1. A person of Asian or Pacific Islander descent,
- 2. GPA of a 3.0 or higher*, and
- 3. Must be enrolled in an undergraduate community, public, or private institutions in the state of Massachusetts. Proof can be provided by submitting an unofficial transcript*.
 - *First year college student applicants can submit their high school transcript if unofficial grades are unavailable.

Important Dates:

- 1. Application due November 8, 2021 by 11:59pm
- 2. Recipient will be chosen and notified by November 22, 2021
- 3. **Only the scholarship winner** will need to submit receipt(s) for reimbursement from the Commonwealth of MA Asian American Commission for books, school supplies, or tuition up to the respective value of the scholarship (\$1000) by or before the end of May 2022.
