

Announcement: The Commonwealth of Massachusetts Asian American Commission's Community Activism Scholarship

Dear Applicant:

The following scholarships are to award students who have demonstrated a strong sense of community activism. We will consider applications from currently enrolled college students and or high school students who wish to continue their studies towards a career in health, human, or social services and/or in civic engagement. The scholarship recipients will have demonstrated passion for community organizing or giving back to the to the Asian American and Pacific Islander communities in Massachusetts. **Three (3) recipients** will each receive a **\$500** scholarship. Note: Applicants may apply for other AAC scholarships but will be limited to being awarded only one of the scholarships they apply for.

The scholarship committee will determine which (3) applicants get awarded the scholarship listed above.

Applicant Criterion:

- 1. A person of Asian or Pacific Islander descent,
- 2. College Applicants: Must be enrolled in an undergraduate community, public, or private institutions in the state of Massachusetts; High School Applicants: Must be enrolled in a high school in the state of Massachusetts. Proof of enrollment can be provided by submitting an unofficial transcript.

- 2. Recipient will be chosen and notified by November 22, 2021
