 - b. Gardner Public Hearing Summary The MCSW conducted a hybrid hearing in Gardner, Mass, to hear from the residents in Worcester County. The event took place at Wachusett Community College as a hybrid event with over 60 total attendees. There were 311 individuals who viewed the livestream during or after the hearing, and 19 views on YouTube. The in-person event began with networking and registration, followed by welcomes and introductions from the Chair. Majority of the hearing was focused on public testimonies, and it concluded with an exit survey and a closing. Testimony from both in-person and virtual participants highlighted the importance of legislative action on various issues, including predatory lending and discrimination against black women, comprehensive sexual health & education, nursing/birthing justice, housing discrimination and non-disclosure agreements/No rehire provision.
