Survey Subcommittee Bi-Weekly Meetings

The meeting discussed updates on the survey report, with Masha Sundararaman

providing the latest version (v5) and addressing rounding errors in the data. Shubhecchha Dhaurali mentioned the report's length and the need for an executive summary. The team planned the survey event, including roles, refreshments, and logistics. Key speakers were confirmed: Dr. Watanabe, Jaya, Danielle, Masha, and Steve for the results presentation. Community impact statements from Miao Chu, Commissioner Bahar Hussein, Evan Owens, and Chahat Kalia were discussed. The event will be held on June 6, with a Zoom live stream and in-person attendance.

Outline

Report Updates and Style Guide

- Shubhecchha Dhaurali and Masha Sundararaman discuss the updated style guide and the reconfiguration of figures.
- Masha Sundararaman mentions a rounding error in the total figures and offers to send the latest version of the report, version 5.
- Shubhecchha Dhaurali confirms the receipt of the updated report and discusses the need for a demographics table.
- Masha Sundararaman offers to create a table for the demographics section and suggests noting the use of unweighted data in the report.

Finalizing the Report and Meeting Logistics

- Shubhecchha Dhaurali updates the team on Joelle's email regarding the report's length and the need for an additional fee.
- The final report is in Word format, consolidating Dr. Watanabe and Shubhecchha Dhaurali's writing.
- Shubhecchha Dhaurali shares the report's structure, including sections on economic concerns, political behavior, executive orders, and safety.
- The total page count is 61, and Shubhecchha Dhaurali asks Joelle about the cost of

creating an executive summary.

Survey Event Planning

- Shubhecchha Dhaurali outlines the public agenda for the survey event, including a welcome, results presentation, policy roundtable, community impact remarks, and closing.
- The team discusses the need for roles assignment, AV equipment setup, and refreshments for the event.

- The community impact statements are from Miao Chu, Commissioner Bahar Hussein, Evan Owens, and Chahat Kalia.

Community Impact Statements and Q&A

- Karen Chen suggests switching the order of the community impact statements and legislative roundtable for better context.
- Shubhecchha Dhaurali agrees to the suggested order and plans to include a Q&A session after the legislative roundtable.
- Masha Sundararaman sends the latest version of the slides, including a demographic section and explanations for disaggregations.
- The team discusses the need for translation services for non-English speakers and the importance of addressing housing affordability in the event.

Final Preparations and Communications

- Shubhecchha Dhaurali requests final edits to the report by the end of the business day to meet Joelle's deadline.
- The team discusses the partner toolkit and op-ed draft, with Karen Chen offering to be a byline author.
- Shubhecchha Dhaurali plans to send a summary email after the meeting to ensure

everyone is on the same page.
